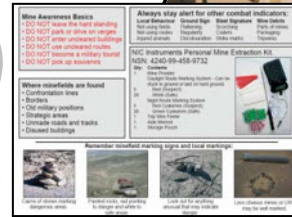

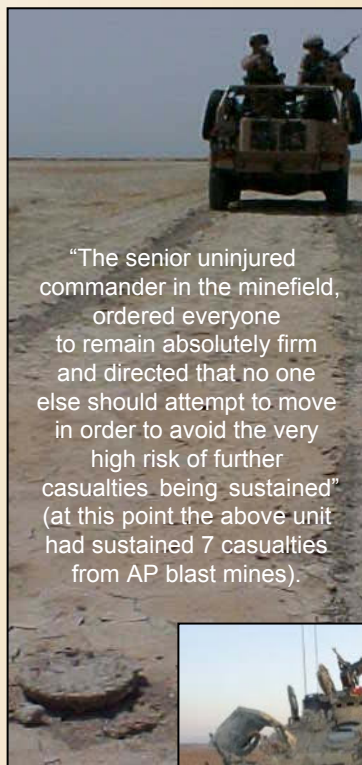

Think, can you use a metal detector in this situation, if so:
LOOK - FEEL - METAL DETECT to safety



"The senior uninjured commander in the minefield, ordered everyone to remain absolutely firm and directed that no one else should attempt to move in order to avoid the very high risk of further casualties being sustained" (at this point the above unit had sustained 7 casualties from AP blast mines).
